Clarence Thomas (Manny) Jules



- Jules was first elected to the Kamloops First Nation Band council in 1974. In 1984 he was elected chief and he remained chief for 12 years. He was a founding member of the Shuswap Nation Tribal Council and helped establish the Secwepemc Heritage Park.
- Another major achievement for Jules was the establishment of the Centre for Excellence in Municipal-Aboriginal Relations. The Center was announced June 1996; this Center is a joint initiative of the taxation board, the Federation of Canadian Municipalities, and Indian Affairs.
